## IMPORTANT DEADLINES

**28 May 2020** - submission of the abstract, in electronic form (Word format) to the national conference organizer, as:

"section number\_last\_name.doc"

**10 June 2020** - acceptance of the submitted abstracts.

**8 September 2020** - registration of participants.

**9-11 September 2020** - conference works.

The costs of the conference organization are *partially* covered by the project BSB27 for the invited lecturers (the publishing of the abstract book, visibility materials, coffee breaks, conference dinner, local transportation, meals and accommodation). Members of the project BSB27 and invited speakers do not pay registration fee.
